Dear Club Secretary/Treasurer,

ENGLAND NETBALL MEMBERSHIP FEES - 2018/2019 SEASON

The new season comes around again all too quickly so now is the time to start planning for your Club's affiliations for the forthcoming 2018/19 Season. All fees are sent direct to England Netball who then forward the SCNA part of the fee back direct to Surrey – see also note ### below. Both EN and SCNA's fees remain unchanged for this new season which is good news for everyone.

EN has issued an "Affiliation Toolkit" to assist you with the affiliation process and these are available to download from EN's Web site. Please read all this information carefully.

The MyNet system is due to go live on Wednesday 1st August 2018 at 10 am when you can then start your affiliations for 2018/2019.

* This fee is only payable by Clubs outside Surrey who affiliate to England Netball via another County.

** Junior Players (Under 18, 14 and 11) – their dates of birth **MUST** be supplied and should be calculated on 1 September in the year of membership.

England Netball will also pass on the Regional Fee of £1.00 where applicable (and pay this direct to the Region) with the remainder of the fee being paid to Surrey County.

Please supply full names, addresses (including postcode), telephone numbers and e mail addresses of your players to EN – this will ensure they receive their copy of the EN Magazine. Please also supply all birth dates.

Please note that NON playing Secretaries/Treasurers MUST still be affiliated but can, where appropriate, chose the Social and Supporting Membership Category. This category includes anyone who does not play, coach or officiates and does not provide Personal Accident Insurance.

Once members have been affiliated and their membership fee has been paid EN will send an e mail. A User Guide can be downloaded to explain how to print an individual's membership card.

IMPORTANT

Unless players (and officials) are affiliated they are NOT insured to participate in any netballing activity. After 1st September 2018 a participant will not receive any Liability or Personal Accident Insurance Cover until their 2018/19 affiliation has been activated, fees paid to EN and showing as active on EN's computer system. Please also ensure that your affiliation is paid prior to your first league match/tournament - checks will be made.

Clubs can affiliate players online at any time but should be aware of the deadlines for affiliations imposed by the Rules of the various leagues within Surrey. Failure to affiliate by the date specified by the individual Leagues could mean your Club forfeiting hard earned points or being ineligible for competitions.

Finally, if you are no longer Secretary or your Secretary changes during the course of the Season, it is extremely important that you notify me, the SCNA Secretary (Jackie Rowland -jbr51@hotmail.co.uk) and ENGLAND NETBALL in writing (affiliations@englandnetball.co.uk) to ensure that your Club continues to receive information from both the County as well as England Netball. Thank you for your co-operation.
