



PROTOCOLS FOR CLUBS, UMPIRES AND SCORERS AT SCNA COUNTY LEAGUE MATCHES

PRE-MATCH

1. The home team for each match will ensure a suitable scoring table/chairs and officials' area.
2. The umpires for each match will ensure that there are enough timing devices to control the match, intervals and injury
3. The home team for each match will supply a hooter (air horn) to be used to signal the end of each quarter/the match. The umpires whistle to control the start/end of play.
4. Each team will provide a copy of the Score Sheet for the match, as per the attached form. The scorers for both teams should be identified to the umpires as soon as possible before the start of the match and if there is any change of scorer during the match.
5. The umpires will confirm the agreed start time of the match to the scorers who will then advise of the time (i. 15 minutes before time. ii. 2 minutes before time. iii. 30 seconds before time. iv. 10 seconds before time.).

DURING THE MATCH

6. The scorers will record and agree the score at every goal scored on the score sheets provided and check the next centre pass. The scorers to display the score on the flip chart provided
7. The scorers will maintain the timing of each quarter of the match and respond immediately to the umpires' requests for a time out for any reason.
8. The scorers will maintain the timing of each timeout and, if for blood, illness or injury, advise the umpires when 10 seconds remain of the maximum 30 seconds.
9. The scorers will maintain the timing of each interval between quarters and advise the umpires when 30 seconds and when 10 seconds are remaining.
10. The scorers will record any Ordering Off or Suspension decided upon by the umpires and respond to their instructions.
11. The scorers will not coach or encourage their team during play from the scorer's table.

POST MATCH

12. The home team will provide and ensure the Result Sheet is completed and signed by the captains and umpires **and** e-mail the Result Sheet as directed by the League.
13. These regulations are in addition to the Regional League rules.

NO POST MATCH – REFRESHMENTS
