12. UPDATE ON OFFICIATING PROGRAMME

Jackie Penney gave a verbal update of the new EN on-line programme of officiating courses and the arrangements for assessments and testing. The Pilot scheme that Surrey was involved with has proved successful and there has been a high take up of places on the online courses which are now organized by EN not the counties. Written tests are on line but final practical test remains 'in person' responsibility for the delivery of these is with counties.
