	3	Take your written assessment This is a 30 minutes written exam assessing learners' knowledge of the rules. It consists of 20 multiple-choice questions and a small selection of free text questions. A pass on the written paper is valid for 2 years.	Payable to EN Included as part of the course fee.	Applications can be made via Application form on the England Netball website. 	4	Arrange a match assessment A match assessment is an opportunity for an experienced umpire to observe you and let you know if you are ready to proceed to your practical assessment.
